	Items that can be laundered should then be dried on the highest possible heat setting for 30 minutes, with the original plastic bag immediately discarded outside the structure. Do not overfill the dryer. After the dry cycle, immediately remove the contents and place in a new plastic bag and seal tightly.		During your 30 day bed bug program, please do not introduce any new furniture into the environment. At the end of your treatment program, Bug Off will make recommendations as to whether additional treatment may be necessary or if it is advisable to bring in new furniture. CUSTOMER ACKNOWLEDGMENT
